COOKIE NUM NUM



- 2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 cup butter (softened)
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 3/4 cup brown sugar (packed)
- 2 large eggs
- 2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips



DIRECTIONS

(Makes about 4 dozen cookies)

- Heat oven to 375 F
- In a bowl, combine the flour, baking soda and salt.
- In a large mixing bowl, beat butter, sugar, brown sugar and vanilla extract at medium speed until creamy.
- Add eggs one at a time. Mix on low speed until each are incorporated.
- Gradually blend dry mixture into wet mixture. Once mixed, stir in the chocolate chips gently.
- Drop by tablespoon onto ungreased baking sheets.
- Bake for 9 to 11 minutes or until golden brown.
- Cool on baking sheets for a few minutes then transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.

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
